





<u>Vinyl Chain Link</u>

Vinyl-coated chain link fence comes in black, green, brown and white color. In contrast with galvanization, PVC-coating provides better performance in improving appearance and corrosion and rust resistance. It is for this reason, color-coated chain link fence is increasingly applied by more and more customers. They can be found in residential garden, yard and commercial park, business area and athlete fields

Chain Link

Made of galvanized steel, chain link fences cannot be destroyed by pests nor rot.
Chain link does not attract dirt or debris, and it never needs painting or staining. Other than occasionally sweeping off leaves and cobwebs, a chain link fence is little to low maintenance. No Climb Fence

No Climb Fencing is specifically designed to keep larger animals contained preventing them from climbing over.

This fence features: 1", 2" and 4" inch woven squares.













Barbed Wire Fence

Barbed Wire Fences consist of 2-4 longitudinal wires twisted together to form cable and having wire barbs wound around either or both of the cable wires at regular intervals.

Extremely effective in keeping wildlife out.

Welded Wire Fence

Welded Wire fence is actually made by spot-welding the intersections of the horizontal and vertical wires. The mesh pattern creates a spacing that is typically between 1/2" and 4" apart. The construction creates a rigid enclosure for a firm barrier.

Cable Wire Fence

A cable fence simply replaces traditional balusters with thin, discreet stainless steel cable. That cable is usually made from stainless or galvanized steel, and it varies in thickness.











Stucco Fence

Stucco is made of cement, water, sand, plus lime. Stucco is breathable — it has tiny pores that allow water to evaporate from behind it so that moisture doesn't build up and cause rot. Stucco may also be combined with other materials, such as: wrought iron, wood & vinyl.

Block Fence

Are you looking for a longlasting fence? A concrete block wall is a wall made up of standard size concrete blocks. The standard size is 8 inches, however, depending on the design parameters and standards set by an engineer for the concrete structure, the block sizes may vary




